



Time to Swim! School District of Beloit Opens High School Pool for Community Members

June 21, 2024 – The School District of Beloit is graciously opening up the Beloit Memorial High School pool for open swim so that Beloit residents can beat the heat this weekend while Krueger Pool is closed for repairs.

Beloit Memorial High School is located at 1225 4th Street.

The City of Beloit is partnering with the school district on this initiative and will run the operations with existing staff and lifeguards.

The hours of operation are:

- Saturday, June 22, 2-6pm
- Sunday, June 23, 11am-6pm
- Monday, June 24, 12-6pm

Regular Krueger Pool admission fees are in effect for these special swim sessions. Krueger Pool is expected to reopen Tuesday, weather permitting.

Krueger Pool rules will remain in effect at the BMHS pool, including supervision for children ages 11 and younger and no pool floaties. We will have U.S. Coast Guard-approved personal floatation devices available for use at the pool. Please note, the shallowest section of the high school pool is 4 feet deep.

Limited concessions will be available (sorry, no ice cream). However, no food or drinks can be taken onto the pool deck. There will be a lounge area right outside of the pool where food and beverages can be consumed. Guests will have access to the locker rooms but should bring their own lock to secure belongings.

Pool guests should park on the north side of the main parking lot at the high school.
