There will be a Public Information Meeting on **Tuesday, August 13**, from 5:00 - 6:00pm at the City of Beloit Water Resources & Engineering Facility located at 2400 Springbrook Ct. for the following projects:

- Strong Avenue Reconstruction (Prairie Ave to Central Ave)
- Emerson Street Reconstruction (Central Ave to Milwaukee Rd) and Hobart Place Water Main Replacement



We do not have a construction schedule for these projects yet, but anticipate awarding contracts at the City Council meeting on August 19.
