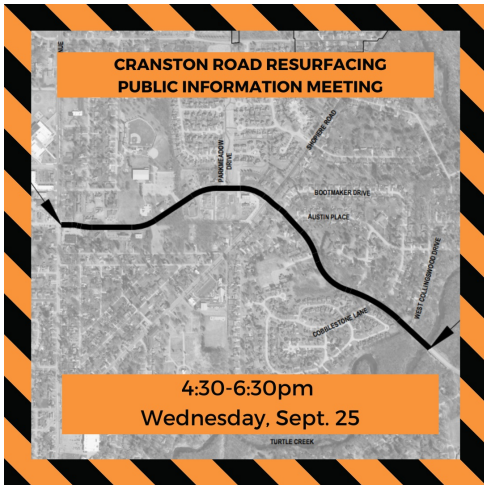

Cranston Road is scheduled to undergo resurfacing from Prairie Avenue to the Turtle Creek bridge just past Collingswood Drive.

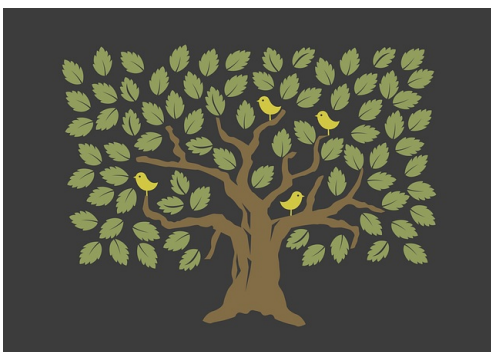
Leaf Vacuum Subscription Service
