

Provide Input on Willowbrook Road Project

The City of Beloit is seeking the community's feedback on options for Willowbrook and Colley Road improvements, including for the intersection of Milwaukee/Willowbrook that is being considered as a signalized intersection or a roundabout.

A public involvement meeting is being held from 4:30-6:30pm Tuesday, October 8, 2024, at Department of Public Works' Engineering and Water Resources building, 2400 Springbrook Road, Beloit.

Demolition of 80-100 E. Grand Ave.

Contractors are working on the building and have started removing the rooftop units.

The process to demolish the building will take several months. After the building is removed, a vibrant public riverwalk will be built in the area while future private redevelopment is planned for the site.


