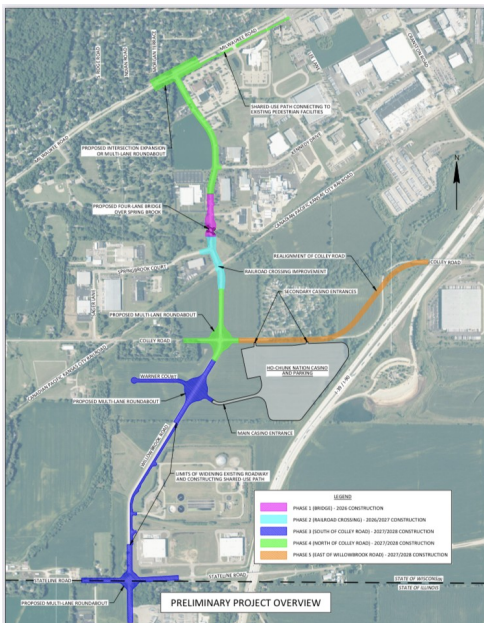


City Council Meeting - Monday, October 7, 2024
