Ho-Chunk Gaming Beloit Groundbreaking - October 25, 2024

The Ho-Chunk Nation broke ground today on a \$405 million casino, hotel and conference center to be located on a 32-acre site on the southeast corner of Willowbrook and Colley roads. When the 240,478-sq-ft Beloit casino opens in 2026, it will be the second largest casino in the state and feature slot machines, table games, a sportsbook, restaurants and bar. A second phase of construction will add a multi-story hotel and conference center.

The City of Beloit will operate seven polling locations for the Tuesday, November 5, 2024 general election. Residents can visit www.myvote.wi.gov to find their polling location. The seven polling locations in the City of Beloit are open from 7am to 8pm. All polling places are accessible to elderly and disabled voters.

Wisconsin Gov. Evers, DNR Announce **Stewardship Program Projects**

The Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program will fund more than \$7.7 million in grant funding through 12 statewide projects.

Beloit is the recipient of \$766,133 in grant funding to assist with completing the public riverwalk construction along E. Grand Ave. in downtown Beloit. Currently, the building at 80-100 E. Grand Ave. over the Rock River is being demolished. The project will decrease flood elevations upstream and promote outdoor recreation with the extension of the Rock River Trail/Downtown Riverwalk.

The riverwalk construction along East Grand Avenue is expected to be completed by summer 2025. The City of Beloit is funding \$500,000 for the riverwalk extension.

USS Beloit Commissioning

The U.S. Navy will commission the future USS Beloit (LCS 29), a Freedom-variant littoral combat ship, on November 23, 2024, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

LCS 29 will be the first commissioned ship in naval service bearing the name of Beloit, WI. The naming of LCS 29 honors the contributions the people of Beloit have made to the U.S. Navy, such as the Fairbanks Morse plant, which built engines that power many of the Navy's ships and submarines, including USS Beloit.

As the ship's sponsor, retired Army Maj. Gen. Marcia M. Anderson will lead the time-honored Navy tradition of giving the order during the ceremony to "Man our ship and bring her to life!" At that moment, the commissioning pennant is hoisted, and the Beloit becomes a proud ship of the fleet.

The future USS Beloit (LCS 29) commissioning ceremony will be livestreamed at <u>//www.dvidshub.net/webcast/35146</u>. The webcast will begin at 9:45 a.m. EST and the ceremony begins at 10 a.m. EST, Nov. 23.


