City Council Candidate Information

Beloit City Council candidate information is now available on the City's website. The 2025 election process for a two year term on the City Council is underway.

December 1, 2024 was the first day to circulate nomination papers. All completed forms are due to the City Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 7, 2025.

The spring election is held on Tuesday, April 1, 2025 and all newly elected Councilors will take office on Tuesday, April 15, 2025.

Anyone interested in running for City Council may pick up an information packet including nomination papers on the 2nd floor lobby during normal business hours: Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Traffic Calming Project

We will soon start narrowing Milwaukee Road east of Turtle Creek in an attempt to slow traffic leading into the Milwaukee Road/White Avenue curve. Paint and barricades will be installed to help calm traffic in the area.

The traffic calming project is in response to resident requests to slow speeds at the intersection, as well as a review of traffic speeds and traffic crashes in that area.

The project is funded through the U.S. Department of Transportation Safe Streets and Roads for All, with a 20% local cost share. We will review speed data at the intersection to determine if this will be a temporary or permanent solution.

Winter Weather Emergency Alerts

The City of Beloit Department of Public Works responds to snow and ice storms of all kinds, with dozens of employees working to keep the roads clear each winter.

While the City of Beloit has alternate side parking year-round, no vehicles can be parked on city streets during a declaration of a winter weather emergency. You can sign up for email and text alerts so you're one of the first to know when the city declares a winter weather emergency.

Protect Your Pipes: Useful Tips for Winter Weather

Temperatures are dropping, and the City of Beloit Water Resources offers some winter maintenance tips to prevent freezing pipes:

- Check the temperature of your water
- Prevent freezing of service lateral by keeping water moving
- Check heating components
- Be careful when thawing frozen pipes
- Check empty and vacant buildings
- Check for cold air drafts
- Make plans while traveling
- Ensure drains and other plumbing equipment works properly
- Disconnect garden hoses and shut off the water flowing to outside spigots
