

Beloit Public Library Provides Help with College FAFSA

College-bound students and their families will receive free assistance completing the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at Beloit Public Library from 6:00-8:30 p.m. on Thursday, January 16.

Volunteer financial aid professionals and educators will be on hand to provide one-onone help for students and their families in completing the FAFSA. Students who attend, submit their FAFSA, and complete a short survey are entered into a drawing for a \$1,000 scholarship to a school of their choice!

If you have Wednesday or Thursday solid waste collection, the solid waste curbside collection schedule will be delayed by one day the week of January 1.

Dog License Renewal

On January 1 of each year, dog owners are required to license all dogs aged 5 months or over. Owners are required to provide proof of their current rabies vaccination, which also shows the tag numbers and the expiration dates.

The fee is \$10/spayed or neutered dog; the fee for all other dogs is \$20/dog. If the dog is licensed after April 1, there is a \$10 late fee imposed unless you are a new resident of the city or if the dog is newly acquired. Dog licenses expire December 31.

Non compliance may result in the issuance of a citation.

Holiday wreaths/garland can be disposed of in trash carts on your regularly scheduled collection day.




