### Grand Avenue Bridge Closure

The Grand Avenue Bridge is closed from State Street to the west end of the bridge. The bridge closure will be in place until the Riverwalk expansion is completed in June, 2025. Please take alternate bridges to get to your destination.

Pedestrians must use the Broad Street bridge or the pedestrian bridge until the work is completed.

The 27th National Prescription Drug Take Back Day is **Saturday, April 26, 2025**. This event is a safe, convenient, and responsible way to dispose of unused or expired prescription drugs. The collection includes controlled and uncontrolled substances, over-the-counter medications, ointments, patches, creams, non-aerosol sprays, vials, and pet medications.

It's easy to participated in Drug Take Back Day. Just stop by a collection site and drop your items into a bin. No questions asked.

The Rock County Sheriff's Office, 200 US-14, Janesville, will be open as a collection site on April 26, 2025 from 9am - Noon.

The Beloit Police Department, 100 State Street, has a permanent drug drop box open 24/7, just inside the doors at City Hall.
