Outdoor Farmers' Market Returns May 3

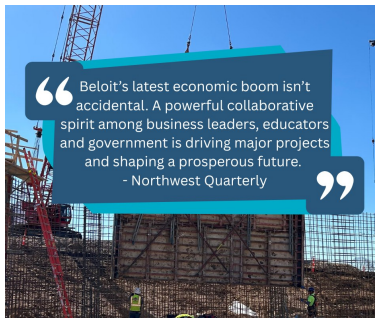
The Downtown Beloit Farmers' Market returns to the outdoors starting this Saturday! Rain or shine, vendors will be downtown from May through October, 8am - 1pm, with locally grown produce, baked goods, cheeses, and more!

New in 2025: The market has expended! The intersection of State Street and Grand Avenue will now be fully closed to vehicle traffic, giving shoppers more space to shop and stroll.

Reminder: The Grand Avenue bridge is closed due to the riverwalk construction project. Pedestrians can use the walking bridge to the north or the Broad Street bridge. Vehicle traffic can use the Broad Street or Shirland Avenue bridges.

Another reminder: **No pets allowed.** Only Service Animals are allowed at the market. We love pets, but for health and safety reasons, they must stay home. Emotional Support Animals are not considered service animals.
