### **BUDGET PREPARATION UPDATE**

We had the budget workshop with the City Council on Monday evening prior to the regularly scheduled Council meeting. The Finance Director and City Manager both presented background information and an update on anticipated revenue available for the 2014 calendar year. Departments and Divisions are now completing their operating budget submittals and the budget review team will meet with all Division and Department Directors in mid-July for a line item review of every budget submittal.

The next public presentation of the budget is the official presentation, which will take place on **Monday, October 7, 2013** during the regular City Council meeting. We have tentatively set aside Monday, October 14 for a full-day workshop with Councilors to hear presentations from all of the Division and Department Directors, and of course, there will be a formal public hearing on the budget as part of the regular City Council agenda for the October 21 meeting.

All budget review sessions are open meetings and the public is invited to attend.
