Attempted 1st Degree Intentional Homicide

On 02/18/14 at 6:20pm Beloit Police were summoned to a residence in the 300 block of Short St. in the City of Beloit in regards to a stabbing incident. Responding officers made contact with victim Vicky Wilson, 44 yrs. of age, Beloit, who had exited the dwelling. Vicky Wilson had suffered a stab wound to her hand. The suspect then exited the dwelling and surrendered to law enforcement without incident. The suspect had a cut to a hand.

The officers then entered the dwelling and discovered victim Bobbie Wilson, 72 yrs. of age, Beloit, lying on a bed in a bedroom. Bobbie Wilson suffered multiple stab wounds to his person.

Both victims were subsequently transported by Beloit Fire Paramedics to Beloit Memorial Hospital for treatment of their injuries. Vicky Wilson was treated and released. Bobbie Wilson was transferred to Mercy Hospital in Janesville. The suspect was transported to Beloit Memorial Hospital by Beloit Police for treatment. All parties reside together.

The suspect, Luis Munoz, 23, Beloit was arrested for Attempted First Degree Intentional Homicide. The matter remains under investigation.
