### FRIENDS AT BELOIT LIBRARY (FABL) ANNUAL BOOK SALE

The event, which began on Thursday, April 24, will conclude at 1 PM on Saturday, April 26. The Beloit Library is located at 605 Eclipse Blvd. in the South end of the Eclipse Center. #### **EARTH DAY CELEBRATION TOMORROW**

Tomorrow, Saturday, April 26, 2014 several events are scheduled to be held in Riverside Park to celebrate Earth Day. Welty Environmental Center, Visit Beloit, Friends of Riverfront, Beloit Memorial High School Environmental Club, Stateline Community Foundation and the City of Beloit Leisure Services are jointly sponsoring a number of free public events to commemorate Earth Day. The theme of the day is "Celebrating Nature's Kaleidoscope: a Community Earth Day Event," with activities ongoing from 9:00 AM until 1:00 PM. Residents are encouraged to attend

Also on Saturday morning the City of Beloit will be coordinating a plaque unveiling on the Wood Family Bridge beginning at 10:00 AM. The plaque will be installed on the bridge just west of the replica locomotive. The plaque describes the historical significance of the replica locomotive that is fixed above the bridge. The locomotive is a replica of Fairbanks Morse and Company's first diesel-electric locomotive called "Milwaukee Road 1802." The plaque was donated to the City of Beloit by the Grutzner Family in memory of Fritz Grutzner, one of several key contributors to the design of the locomotive.

At 11:00 a.m. an interactive public art installation will be celebrated in Riverside Park, just south of the Moore Pavilion on the plaza area. Local Environmental clubs and green agencies will also be present with information and interactive activities for adults and children. #### BELOIT UTILITIES NOW OFFERS E-STATEMENTS FOR CUSTOMER CONVENIENCE

We again want to remind customers that Beloit Utilities is now offering an option for E-statements. This option offers a new, more convenient way for you to manage your bills and maintain electronic files as well. This option will improve convenience for customers who utilize their computers for managing their personal business affairs and also save the City of Beloit Water Utility the cost of paper, printing and postage to send the traditional paper bill. If you are interested in signing up for E-statements, please click <a href="here">here</a> for a link to the appropriate page. You will need your account number, and of course an e-mail address. Simply complete the form and transition your future bills to an electronic format.

The Utility will continue to send paper statements each month to customers that would prefer to receive a traditional paper document for processing their monthly payments. No action needs to be taken to maintain the paper bills that you currently receive.

### **CITY WEBSITE ADDRESS CHANGING**

We want to again remind everyone that the City's website and e-mail addresses are changing.

At the request of our Information Technology office, the City has decided to update and simplify its website address. Also, the current website www.ci.beloit.wi.us does not belong to the city and the lease on this name ends on January 1, 2015. It is unknown at this time whether or not it will be affordable to renew use of that name. The city now has access to the "gov" suffix which will also be used in implementing the shorter, more simplified website address of <a href="http://www.beloitwi.gov">http://www.beloitwi.gov</a>.

This name is not only easier and shorter, but is more intuitive as well. Along with the change, all of the City's email addresses will also be transitioned. For example, the City Manager's former e-mail address was <a href="mailto:artil@ci.beloit.wi.us">artil@ci.beloit.wi.us</a>. The new e-mail address is now <a href="mailto:artil@beloitwi.gov">artil@beloitwi.gov</a>.

As noted above, the current website and e-mail addresses will remain valid at least through the end of this calendar year until January 1, 2015. If the owner of that address provides the City with a reasonable renewal cost, it is likely that the City will retain that address as well. Both addresses will take the sender to either the appropriate website or City office. We would suggest, however, that you reprogram your favorites, bookmarks and contacts to reflect the new or abbreviated address for City electronic communications.
