Good Morning Jason,

Jason My name is Todd Kaiser, I am the owner of One Reynolds LLC. One Reynolds LLC is my property in Beloit WI. Most commonly known as the Alcoa Facility.

Jason I am contacting you this morning to ask that you will consider removing the "No Parking" signs on the North and South sides of Kennedy Dr on the south border of my property.

June of 2014 we were successful in winning the bid to secure Axium Foods of South Beloit, IL to lease 120,000 sq ft +/- of our building. Axium Foods uses our space for Inbound & Outbound Distribution of their food products. Their decision to lease from us brought approximately 25 jobs to Beloit.

As of June 12, 2015 we were successful in securing a 140,000 sq ft +/- lease with Con Agra (Corporate Office – Omaha NE) in our Reynolds property. ConAgra will also be using their space for Inbound and Outbound Distribution which will be supporting their South Beloit IL food processing facility. ConAgra will also now have employees here in Beloit.

Both of these companies recognized the excellent condition and layout of the road systems in our Industrial Park here in Beloit and this was very helpful in their decision making process.

As I am sure you are aware of Inbound and Outbound Distribution can drive ebbs and tides of Inbound and Outbound Class 8 (Tractor – Trailers) arriving and leaving 7/24/365. With my tenants needs in mind I am requesting that the "No Parking" signs be removed on both the North and South sides of Kennedy Dr to allow for parking as the need may arise.



1.	Vicki Jentoft-Johnson relayed concerns she had regarding vehicles blocking driveways, emergency vehicle access near the school general traffic flow.					
2.	The City met with School officials and discussed potential changes for the parking lot and pick-up/drop-off area. The School District suggested re-opening the exit on Colley with right-turn/left-turn designations in the parking lot. This area is currently coned off, forcing all vehicles to enter from Colley and exit on Oakwood.					
3.	Another suggestion was make sure that all changes and suggestions for travelling though the school zone be communicated to the parents before the start of the new school year.					
4.	Ms. Jentoft-Johnson also asked about the ability to paint the curbs to depict No-Parking areas. Currently, the City of Beloit does not have a curb painting program in residential areas. Our practice has been to indicate these areas with the use of No-Parking signage.					
5.	Finally, it was suggested that increased enforcement of the traffic patterns is established with the use of existing school staff and if needed, increased Police presence.

Good morning Vicki,

As part of the education process for the new traffic pattern at Todd School, I will be relaying information related to your concerns to the Police Department at our upcoming Traffic Review Committee meetings. I have been working with the Police Department this past year at various school locations throughout the City to help with traffic/safety issues and will continue to do so throughout this year as the remaining school transition takes place. I would ask for your patience during the transition to the new traffic pattern for the upcoming school year as it will take some time for the parents to adjust.

The City does not paint the curbing in residential areas to designate No-Parking areas. The No-Parking locations throughout the City are typically indicated with the use of signage. The enforcement of the signage and other statutes is the responsibility of the Police Department. As indicated, I will make sure that the Police are aware of your concerns.
