PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING THE CITY OF БЕЛОIT POWERHOUSE RIVERWALK AND THE БЕЛОIT COLLEGE POWERHOUSE PROJECTS

Beloit, Wisconsin - The City of Beloit has scheduled a public involvement meeting to discuss plans for the Powerhouse Riverwalk Project along the Rock River. In coordination with the City of Beloit's meeting, officials from Beloit College and Alliant Energy/WPL will be on hand to discuss their plans for the Powerhouse project. The public informational meeting is scheduled from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Tuesday, April 25, 2017 at the Rotary River Center, located at 1160 S. Riverside Drive, Beloit, WI 53511. The meeting will be an open house format.

The meeting will present preliminary design information and renderings, the proposed schedule for the planned Riverwalk improvements, as well as the College's Powerhouse project.

The public is encouraged to attend the meeting, provide input, and ask questions concerning the projects. City of Beloit representatives and designers from Jewell Associates and Batterman will be available to discuss the Riverwalk project on an individual basis. Beloit College representatives and designers from Angus Young Associates will be available to discuss the Powerhouse project.

In addition, the project has potential impacts to the historic Beloit Water, Gas & Electric Co. Powerhouse, located at 850 Pleasant Street.
