### PUBLIC COORDINATION MEETING - PRAIRIE AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION

Construction activities on Prairie Avenue, from Cranston Road to Huebbe Parkway, are scheduled to begin on May 20th. Work on Prairie Avenue consists of excavation, concrete pavement, asphalt pavement, curb and gutter, sidewalk, pavement marking, traffic signals and street lighting, and storm sewer.

WisDOT and Rock Road have scheduled a **Public Coordination Meeting** to inform the public about the upcoming construction project and obtain input. The meeting will discuss the project schedule, including vehicular and pedestrian access during construction. The public is invited to attend the meeting scheduled for **Monday, May 13, 2019, 5:00 to 7:00 p.m.**, Utilities and Engineering Facility Conference Room, 2400 Springbrook Court, Beloit.

The meeting will follow an open house format. A brief presentation about the construction project, including traffic staging, vehicle and pedestrian access, and general work operations will take place at 5:30 p.m. Staff from WisDOT and Rock Road will be on hand to answer questions about the project and receive input.

## **2019 MONTHLY CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF YARD WASTE**

In May, curbside collection of yard waste will take place from May 13 through 16 on your regular trash day.

- Yard waste consists of leaves, grass clippings, garden debris, brush and shrubbery (no larger than 4 feet long and/or 4 inches in diameter).
- All brush and shrubbery must be bundled, tied or contained with a \$1.50 yard waste sticker placed on it.
- Stickers are sold 5 to a sheet for \$7.50 and are available at Walgreens, ACE Hardware, Public Works Operations Facility, City Hall Treasury, and Grinnell Hall.
- Use only paper yard waste bags, Back-to-Nature Biodegradable bags or clean trash containers 39 gallons or less.
- Plastic bags cannot be used for yard waste.
- Yard waste containers must weigh no more than 60 pounds.
- Yard waste must be clean and litter free.
- Place yard waste at least 3 feet away from your regular trash.

## **SPRING TERRACE TREE PLANTING**

The City of Beloit Parks and Recreation Division is currently accepting requests from residents for terrace trees to be planted this spring.

The terrace tree species selection will be determined by the city forestry supervisor while taking into account the size of the terrace, presence of utilities and exotic invasive insects. Trees will be planted on a first-come, first-served basis. A limited supply is available. Forestry will accept requests through Friday, May 24, 2019.
