**City of Beloit Opens Curbside In-Person Voter Registration, Absentee Voting**

March 20, 2020 - In-person voter registration and absentee voting will be completed curbside at Beloit City Hall through April 3, 2020, in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Voters should remain in their cars and await instructions from the poll workers. Enter the City Hall parking lot from Shirland Avenue and follow the signage. If you are not registered to vote, you will be instructed to park in a dedicated stall and an election official will attend to you. Please have your Photo ID (and Proof of Residence if necessary) ready to show.

If you are already registered to vote, we highly encourage you to visit <https://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/> to request an absentee ballot by mail; the request must be received in the Clerk-Treasurer's Office by 5pm April 2. However, we can still accommodate in-person absentee voting in our drive-through service.

We encourage you to bring your own black or blue ballpoint pen (black is preferred) but will have supplies if you forget

The drive-through absentee voting service will continue 8am-5pm Monday through Friday through 5pm Friday, April 3, 2020.
