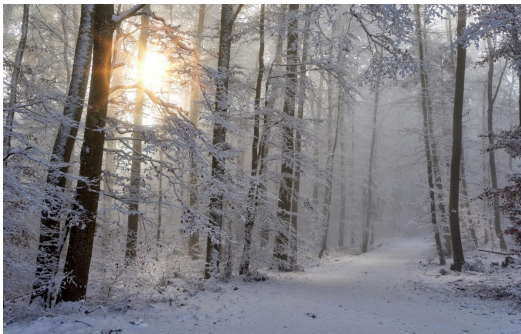


Beloit City Council Meeting Monday, February 1, 2021

Sign Up For Snow Emergency Alerts - Weather Predicts Several Inches This Weekend

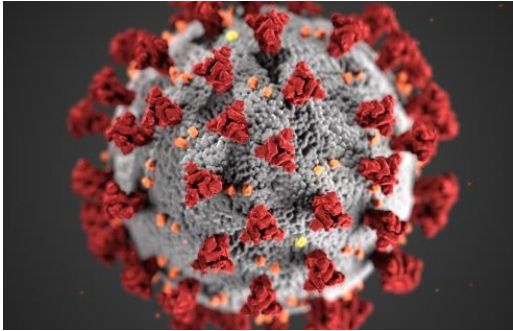
Several inches of snow are predicted to hit Beloit this

Don't forget to clear the sidewalk within 48 hours of the conclusion of the storm. Also, please dig out those fire hydrants!

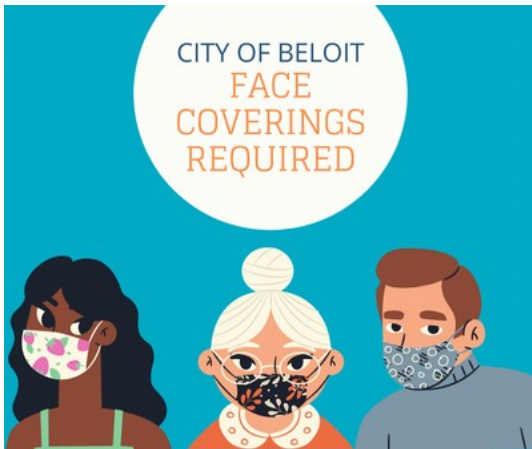


COVID - 19 Testing in Rock County is Extended

FREE COVID-19 testing will be available weekly on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 11 a.m. - 7 p.m. each day at Blackhawk Technical College-Central Campus, 6004 South County Highway G, Janesville. The last day of testing is tentatively scheduled for March 10, 2021.

A new entrance to the site will be in effect. The new entrance will use the US Hwy 51 entrance to the campus. The prior entrance for testing had been off Sunny Lane. The change reflects updated traffic usage.

Beloit City Council Extends COVID-19 Resolution

The Beloit City Council approved a resolution on Monday, Nov. 16, 2020, to ensure that physical distancing and protective measures remain in place to minimize the spread of COVID-19 in Beloit, as well as requiring face coverings in public spaces in the City of Beloit.

The resolution is in effect until further notice. It will take City Council action to rescind the requirements when the City Council determines the threat of COVID-19 has subsided.
