Beloit Public Library is a Warming Shelter

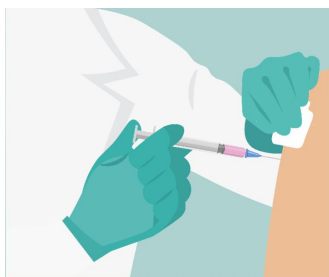
With extremely cold temperatures in the forecast, the City of Beloit reminds residents and community members that the Beloit Public Library is an official warming shelter.

Walk-In Vaccine Clinics at Beloit Public Library

The Beloit Public Library, 605 Eclipse Blvd., will host a series of walk-in COVID vaccine clinics for the public beginning in January.

Staff from Beloit Health System will administer

Pfizer vaccines for people ages 5 and older to provide a convenient option for residents at this once-monthly clinic.

- Thursday, January 13, 1:00 - 3:00 p.m.
- Thursday, February 17, 1:00 - 3:00 p.m.
- Thursday, March 17, 1:00 - 3:00 p.m.
- Thursday, April 21, 1:00 - 3:00 p.m.

No appointment is necessary for participants. First doses and booster shots will be available. Individuals who are coming for a booster need to bring along their vaccine card. Participants younger than 18 must be accompanied by an adult or legal guardian who can provide written consent.
