## Eastlawn and Oakwood Cemeteries Spring Clean-Up Reminder

Eastlawn and Oakwood cemetery staff reminds us that spring clean-up will take place from April 15 - 30th. Patrons should remove any items from grave sites that they wish to keep before April 15th. New decorations may be placed starting May 1st.

Cemetery staff removes decorations, artificial flowers and items not allowed. Planters and shepherd hooks are not removed if still in serviceable condition. American flags that are not serviceable are removed.
