Beloit Receives \$9 Million Grant

Governor Tony Evers was in Beloit this week to present a \$9 million Neighborhood Investment Fund grant to help with the development of a Community Outreach and Engagement Center at Beloit College. The Center will find solutions to complex community problems by fostering collaboration between partnerships that exist between Beloit College and the School District of Beloit, Beloit Health System, the Boys and Girls Club, ACTS Housing, Community Action, the NAACP, and others.

Beloit College plans to renovate Morse Library on campus to house the new Community Outreach and Engagement Center, and when combined with existing programs at Beloit College, it is expected the Center would touch the lives of all 36,000 Beloit residents, especially those who are otherwise underserved.

The City of Beloit applied for the grant on the behalf of Beloit College; this is a pass-through grant and does not require any local tax dollars for the project. Thank you to Governor Evers for this investment in the Beloit community. Congratulations to Beloit College - we can't wait to see the completed project!

The City of Beloit Police Department is partnering with Community Action to hold a series of community meetings in March designed to share information about how to reduce violent crime and other important initiatives.


