March 8, 2022 - The City of Beloit is announcing updated wards for the April 2022 election and providing residents voting information. Due to redistricting, wards and polling locations may have changed. The polling locations are as follows:

Wards 1, 2 & 3	Converse School, 1602 Townline Avenue
Wards 4, 5 & 6	Gaston School, 1515 W. Grand Avenue
Wards 7, 8	Hackett School, 625 Eighth Street
Wards 9, 10, 11	Beloit Historical Society, 845 Hackett Street
Ward 12	First Congregational Church, 801 Bushnell Street
Wards 13, 14	Todd School, 1621 Oakwood Avenue
Wards 15, 16, 17	Beloit Public Library, 605 Eclipse Boulevard
Wards 18, 19, 20	River of Life UMC, 2345 Prairie Avenue
Wards 21, 22, 23	Central Christian Church, 2460 Milwaukee Road

Registration Deadlines:

- Online voter registration (My Vote website): Wednesday, March 16
- In person registration at City Hall: 8am-5pm weekdays
- At the polls: you can register at the polls on Election Day

Absentee Voting Information and Deadlines:

- Deadline to request absentee ballot by mail: 5 p.m. Thursday, March 31, 2022
 - We recommend request being made earlier to ensure ballot is returned via the USPS or delivered to a polling location in person by the 8 p.m. April 5, 2022 deadline. Ballots received after 8 p.m. April 5 will not be counted. USPS recommends mailing ballots back at least one week before the election.
- In person absentee voting: available weekdays at City Hall, 100 State St (use Shirland Avenue parking lot entrance) 8am-4:30 p.m. Tuesday, March 22, 2022, through Friday, April 1, 2022 (available until 5 p.m. on Friday, April 1, 2022)
