MAKE YOUR VOICE HEARD ON APRIL 5TH FOR THE SPRING ELECTIONS!

The clerk-treasurer's office has mailed the first batch of absentee ballots to individuals who requested the ballots for April 5, 2022, election by mail. Ballots should be returned using the United States Postal Service or in-person at City Hall between 8 am and 5 pm Mondays-Fridays. Ballots must be received by 8 pm April 5, 2022, to be counted.

Do not place absentee ballots in either utility bill dropbox. Ballots placed in the drop boxes may not be counted.

Yard Waste Curbside Collections Begins

April's curbside collection of yard waste will take place April 4-7 and April 11-14 on your regularly scheduled solid waste collection day.

Yard waste must be on the curb by 6 a.m. the day of your regular solid waste collection. A \$2 sticker will be required for each bag, container, and bundle.

Yard waste includes contained leaves, grass clippings, garden debris, brush, and shrubbery. No litter allowed.

City of Beloit & Welty Environmental Center Partnering to Offer Compost Program to Community

The Beloit community is invited to put their kitchen scraps to work with a compost bin. The two organizations are hosting a 55-gallon compost bin sale that is now underway for \$55/bin.

These bins are made with 100% recycled materials. Composting allows residents to conveniently process raw food waste like fruit and vegetable scraps, keeping it out of the landfill and helping gardens thrive.

The compost bins can be pre-ordered by sending a form and check to the City of Beloit, by paying with cash or credit card in person at the City of Beloit Public Works Department, 2351 Springbrook Court, 7 am- 4 pm Monday-Friday, or online at www.weltycenter.org (3% credit card convenience fee applies). A total of 90 bins will be ordered. Pick-up will be available in April and May.
