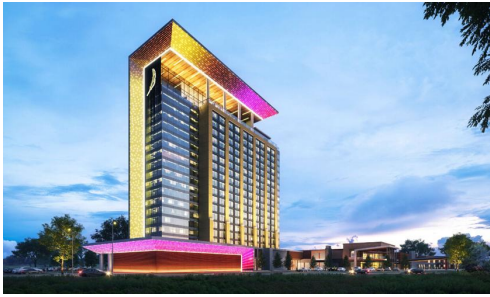
Absentee Ballots Sent This Week
