Area Transit Organizations Kick Off Transit Development Plan Update

February 7, 2025 - Beloit Transit System, Stateline Area Transportation Study, and Stateline Mass Transit District have started to update a five-year Transit Development Plan. The transit organizations are partnering with AECOM to lead the study to better serve communities throughout southern Wisconsin and northern Illinois.

A Transit Development Plan is a strategic planning study that outlines a public transportation system's vision for a five-year period. The process will identify current needs, potential service improvements, and detail a plan to implement changes with a focus on maximizing efficiency and effectiveness of transit operations. The primary goal of the future transit development plan is to improve current transit service by identifying current needs and future opportunities for enhancement.
