Transit Development Plan Open House Events February 11 and 12, 2025

The Stateline Area Transportation Study (SLATS), has scheduled several open house events to share project progress, existing conditions analysis, and hear the community's perspective on transit service performance and opportunities for improvements, including potential service destinations. These sessions will also seek input on transportation needs and service gaps in the greater Beloit area, including areas in northern Illinois that extend down to the Machesney Park and Rockford area.

The open house events are scheduled for:

- Tuesday, Feb. 11, 11:30am to 1:30 pm and from 4:30pm to 6:30pm at the Beloit Transfer Center, 225 Shirland Avenue, Beloit AND
- Wednesday, Feb. 12, from 11:30am to 1:30pm and from 4:30pm to 6:30pm at the Nature at the Confluence, 306 Dickop Street, South Beloit

City Invests \$1M - Seeks Developers for Market-Rate Homes in Beloit

The Beloit City Council voted to invest \$1 million of tax incremental housing funds for developers looking to build in Beloit.

Applications are due March 7, 2025; applicants must be the owner of the property in question or have the project site under contract at the time of application. After receiving approvals, the funding will support the infrastructure of a new housing development, including utilities, roads, sidewalks, bicycle accommodations and landscaping.
